Puppet Book Report

Create a puppet from one of the characters from the book you read. You must be able to hold the puppet and move it around because you are going to give our class a little puppet show. There are many different kinds of puppets; sock, paper bag, hand, and string.

Write a summary of your book from your character's point of view. When you perform your little puppet show, you may read your summary. You do not need to memorize the summary.

To help write your summary, you may choose to use the organizer on the back. A summary should include the names of important characters and locations. It also needs to include important events from the book. You should also include what the main problem and how it was resolved. A page is also provided for your summary.

Remember, your summary needs to be written in the first person point of view. It will be as if your puppet is speaking!

You will want to practice saying your summary in an easy to hear voice that sounds like your character. You will also want to practice moving your puppet.
